## Career Research Project

## **Objectives:**

Students will:

- -Research a variety of careers
- -Use their research skills to develop questions to research about their career
- -Present their research to other students

## **Materials:**

- -Chart Paper and Markers
- -Chromebook / Technology for each child
- -Access to Google Slides or another presentation application

## **Lesson Activities:**

- Tell students we are going to begin a research project based on possible careers they are interested in, encourage students to think of a variety of careers so we could learn about new careers that they might not know about yet.
- 2. Create a master list of careers as a whole group and have students write down their top 3 career ideas they would like to learn about. Based on their choices, assign students a career to research
- After they have their career to research, I would have them come up with
  questions they have about their career. If students need more support with
  coming up with questions, do this as a whole group activity so they all get a
  good variety of questions to search
- 4. Once they have questions to search, I would introduce the Kids Infobits website and show them how to use this resource.
- 5. Allow classwork time to research their career. Depending on your schedule and your kids, you will probably need to allow a few days for this.
- Once their research is done, allow them time to create some way to present their research such as Google Slides or another resource appropriate for your aged students.
- 7. Finally have students present their research project to their classroom, as a parent involvement night, or a school wide show.
